Any student who is absent from a scheduled examination without notification or prior approval may be excluded from that course. Approval to miss a scheduled examination will be given only in cases of serious emergencies and illnesses where the administration is notified in writing. Verification of the emergency or illness is required.

If the administration approves a student's absence from an examination, a make-up examination may be given. Students are charged a \$200.00 make-up fee for each examination they miss. Failure to show up for a scheduled make-up exam will result in a "No-Show" fee of \$100. Please note: normally, no grade higher than a "C" can be earned from a make-up examination.
